Coach's commitment to your team and league:

1. Attend all coaches meetings scheduled by Hanover Warriors and the E2ESYFL.
2. Provide ideas and suggestions on how we as an organization can improve.
3. Participate in Hanover Warriors functions. (fundraisers, coaching clinics, etc...)
4. Be at practices on time or arrange to have other USA certified coaches on your coaching staff at practice on time if you are going to be late.
5. Ensure you are prepared for each practice.
6. Ensure that each player is participating during practice sessions and games.
7. Work with your team director for all administrative responsibilities.
8. Ensure that all equipment that is issued to your team at the beginning of the year is properly safeguarded and returned back to the Hanover Warriors at the final game of the season.
9. Be willing and available to talk with parents as needed.
10. Teach your players fair play and good sportsmanship, to respect the decisions of the officials, that foul language and dirty play will not be tolerated by your coaching staff or the Hanover Warriors.
11. Work with the Hanover Warriors organizers and other coaches in a cooperative manner.
12. Learn and abide by all Hanover Warriors and the E2ESYFL rules.
13. Agree that you will not use alcohol, drugs, abusive language, profanity, and/or tobacco products while officially representing the Hanover Warriors during practices and games.
14. Agree that each player on your team plays a minimum of 2 plays per half. If you are aware of a situation where a player should not play in a game, it is your right not to let the player participate. The child's parents need to be notified prior to the game of the action you are taking.
15. Assist the Hanover Warriors organization in keeping accurate record of each player's grades, and ensure each player is maintaining a C average in school.
16. Ensure there is at least one parent meeting at the beginning of the season and as needed thereafter.
17. Agree to give a copy of all your individual rules to each parent and to your director.
